



Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 10th June 2021 to establish an affiliation by and between the following four institutes for the purpose of exchange of faculty and staff and students.



The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as 'Shri Swami Vivekanand Cluster of PG Centers'.

PREAMBLE

Whereas all the above institutes have many areas of common interest in basic sciences, a considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education, and research. Now, therefore, all above institu1tes have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), collectively as known as 'Shri Swami Vivekananda Cluster of PG Centers' which defines the framework for the cooperation of the four institutions set out in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

All the four institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The four institutions shall seek to promote:

1. Faculty/Staff Exchanges:

- a) The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of four institutions.
- **b)** Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- c) The exchange of academic materials.
- **d)** Online and offline modes of conducting lectures, practicals, and projects.
- e) Undertaking joint research.
- f) Undertaking joint placement camps in the form of campus interviews.
- g) Attachment of staff for purposes of curriculum development and review, attendance of courses, upgrading of teaching and research skills.
- **h)** Organization and participation of seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions.
- i) Co-supervising post-graduate students.
- j) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed upon. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning salaries, travel funding, and housing will be worked out between the institutes. A separate agreement will be entered into giving such details, including terms of exchange.

2. Other Areas:

In addition, all four institutes are going to carry following activities;

- a) To exchange information on research and educational programs.
- b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material, and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs.
- c) To jointly organize short-term continuing education programs on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- d) To organize joint seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- e) To propose and engage jointly in research or training programs sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- f) To exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at Undergraduate, Graduate, and Doctoral levels for limited periods for purpose of education and /or research.
- **g)** The provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of all institutes.
- h) To use laboratory facilities in specific cases for a limited period.
- i) To permit students, staff, and faculty members to use the library facility.

All the institutes agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the four institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a program coordinator from the side of all institutes will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the four institutions.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

All institutes do not absolve any confidential information during the research activity.

ARTICLE 4: VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for FIVE years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 5: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, none of the institutes will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, all will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

ARTICLE 6: AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of all institutes.

ARTICLE 7: ADHERENCE TO LAWS

Participating faculties, staff, and students involved in any activities under this memorandum must adhere to the law, rules, and regulations of the institutions.

ARTICLE 8: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 9: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case, there is a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, principals of all four institutes will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

All four institutes welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions as set out above.
